PAHRUMP TOWN ORDINANCE NO. 10

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE PROOF OF INOCULATION AGAINST RABIES OF DOGS AND CATS WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE UNINCORPORATED TOWN OF PAHRUMP, NYE COUNTY, NEVADA; PROHIBITING THE RUNNING AT LARGE OF DOGS AND THE FREQUENT BARKING, YELPING, AND HOWLING OF DOGS IN ANY MANNER THAT DISTURBS THE PEACE OF ANY NEIGHBORHOOD, WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE UNINCORPORATED TOWN OF PAHRUMP, NYE COUNTY, NEVADA; AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF; AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO.

The Board of Nye County Commissioners, acting as the Board of Trustees of the unincorporated Town of Pahrump, Nye County, Nevada, does hereby ordain as follows:

DOGS AND CATS

10.010 PROOF OF RABIES INOCULATION FOR DOGS AND CATS. In order to protect the public health and welfare of the residents of the unincorporated Town of Pahrump, Nye County, Nevada, it shall be unlawful for any person residing within the limits of the unincorporated Town of Pahrump to own, harbor, control or possess any dog or cat over the age of six months without first having exhibited proof of inoculation against rabies by filing with the Nye County Sheriff's Department, Pahrump Substation, a current certificate indicating the date of such inoculation, the name of the dog or cat so inoculated, the name and address of the owner of the dog or cat, and the date of expiration of the rabies inoculation. In addition thereto, every dog or cat so inoculated shall at all times wear a tag evidencing such rabies inoculation.

10.020 CERTIFICATE OF VACCINATION REQUIRED. A certificate in substantially the following form shall be filed with the Nye County Sheriff's Department, Pahrump Substation, by the person administering such vaccination and shall be signed by said vaccinator to provide proof of inoculation.

10.030 UNLAWFUL TO PERMIT DOGS AND CATS TO RUN AT LARGE. It shall be lawful for the Sheriff of Nye County, any of his deputies, or the animal control officer to pick up and impound any dog or cat found running at large on any public property, public highway, street, alley, court, public ground, or private property, other than the property of the owner of said dog or cat, in the unincorporated Town of Pahrump, Nye County, Nevada, and after the expiration of fourteen (14) calendar days, if said dog or cat has not been claimed, to provide for the disposal thereof in a humane manner.

10.040 FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY FOR IMPOUNDING. The owner of the dog or cat so impounded shall pay all costs incurred by the County of Nye in the impounding and maintaining of said dog or cat, exhibit a valid certificate of rabies inoculation, and shall make restitution for any injury or damage sustained

by other person or persons as a result of the actions of the impounded dog or cat.

10.050 PROHIBITION OF ANIMALS IN COMMUNITY PARKS. It shall be unlawful for any dog or cat, leashed or unleashed, save and except "seeing eye dogs" when accompanied by their master, to be within the fenced area of the grounds commonly known as the "Pahrump Community Park," or within any buildings located thereon, or any other public park or public building located within the unincorporated Town of Pahrump, Nye County, Nevada.

10.060 KENNEL CLUBS AND DOG AND CAT SHOWS EXCEPTION. Nothing in Section 10.050 above shall prohibit any kennel club, dog club or cat club from conducting a meeting or shows on the grounds of the "Pahrump Community Park" provided, however, that said club notifies the Town Manager of the Town of Pahrump, in advance of said show, and receives the permission of the said Town Manager to conduct said show on park grounds.

10.070 BARKING, YELPING, OR HOWLING DOGS--PUBLIC NUISANCE. It shall be unlawful for any person to keep, harbor or possess any dog which by its loud, frequent, and/or consistent barking, yelping, howling, or in any other manner disturbs the peace and quiet of any neighborhood within the unincorporated Town of Pahrump, Nye County, Nevada. Such conduct is hereby declared to be a public nuisance, subject to judicial abatement. Such abatement proceedings shall be initiated by the Sheriff of Nye County, or any of his deputies, or any animal control officer, upon having received a written complaint that a dog is being kept or maintained in violation of this ordinance.

10.080 PENALTIES FOR WILLFUL OR DELIBERATE VIOLATION. All persons guilty of having willfully or deliberately violated any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be given a warning on the first offense, and may be fined TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$25.00) for a second offense, and may be guilty of a misdemeanor on the third offense.

PAHRUMP TOWN ORDINANCE NO. 10

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE PROOF OF INOCULATION AGAINST RABIES OF DOGS AND CATS WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE UNINCORPORATED TOWN OF PAHRUMP, NYE COUNTY, NEVADA; PROHIBITING THE RUNNING AT LARGE OF DOGS AND THE FREQUENT BARKING, YELPING, AND HOWLING OF DOGS IN ANY MANNER THAT DISTURBS THE PEACE OF ANY NEIGHBORHOOD, WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE UNINCORPORATED TOWN OF PAHRUMP, NYE COUNTY, NEVADA; AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF; AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO.

The Board of Nye County Commissioners, acting as the Board of Trustees of the unincorporated Town of Pahrump, Nye County, Nevada, does hereby ordain as follows:

DOGS AND CATS

10.010 PROOF OF RABIES INOCULATION FOR DOGS AND CATS. In order to protect the public health and welfare of the residents of the unincorporated Town of Pahrump, Nye County, Nevada, it shall be unlawful for any person residing within the limits of the unincorporated Town of Pahrump to own, harbor, control or possess any dog or cat over the age of six months without first having exhibited proof of inoculation against rabies by filing with the Nye County Sheriff's Department, Pahrump Substation, a current certificate indicating the date of such inoculation, the name of the dog or cat so inoculated, the name and address of the owner of the dog or cat, and the date of expiration of the rabies inoculation. In addition thereto, every dog or cat so inoculated shall at all times wear a tag evidencing such rabies inoculation.

10.020 CERTIFICATE OF VACCINATION REQUIRED. A certificate in substantially the following form shall be filed with the Nye County Sheriff's Department, Pahrump Substation, by the person administering such vaccination and shall be signed by said vaccinator to provide proof of inoculation.
